

PicWITS!

Sample Pack Rules For 4 or more players

This sample pack was designed to give you a quick glimpse of PicWits—the game that lets you “use your wit to make the caption fit!” The actual rules have been modified to apply to this abbreviated version. For complete rules go to www.mindware.com.

Set Up Separate the Caption Cards from the Picture Cards. Shuffle the Caption Cards and place them in a stack face down in the center of the table. Deal the Picture Cards evenly among the players. Place any remaining Picture Cards to the side.

Playing PicWits is played in rounds and every round needs a judge. Choose a player to be the first judge.

To begin a round, the judge draws the top Caption Card, reads it out loud and places it face up on the table.

All other players look at the Picture Cards in their hands and choose the one they think is the best match to the caption—in the judge’s opinion that is! Each player places his or her chosen Picture Card face down on the table in front of the judge.

Judging Once everyone has played a Picture Card, the judge shuffles the cards so he or she does not know who played which card. The judge then flips over the Picture Cards one at a time so all players can see them. After reviewing each picture, the judge decides which card **IN HIS OR HER OPINION** best fits the caption. The person who played the card wins the round and is awarded the Caption Card. The person sitting to the left of the judge becomes the new judge for the next round. Continuing playing rounds until all Caption Cards have been played.

Winning At the end of the game, the player with the most Caption Cards is the winner.

The full PicWits game includes 504 Picture Cards and 144 Caption Cards. The game is designed for 4 or more players, ages 10 and up.
